**3a. Consider Working Off of the Town of Pomfret's Awarded Bid for Resilient Elastomeric Surface Treatment for Overlay Restoration (RESTOR)**

John Navarro, Public Works Director, was at the meeting along with Paul Montenegro of Black Mountain Roadwork Protocols to review the specifics of this (RESTOR) technique with the Selectmen. Pomfret had been looking for a different process for paving and went out to bid for this process. Mr. Montenegro explained that RESTOR is an asphalt rejuvenator used to preserve pavement. It is a water-based material that when applied goes through the pavement (not just on top of it) and softens the top 1" layer, preventing it from becoming brittle. John Navarro is looking for permission from the Selectmen to use the bid from Pomfret to do a couple of roads in Woodstock.
