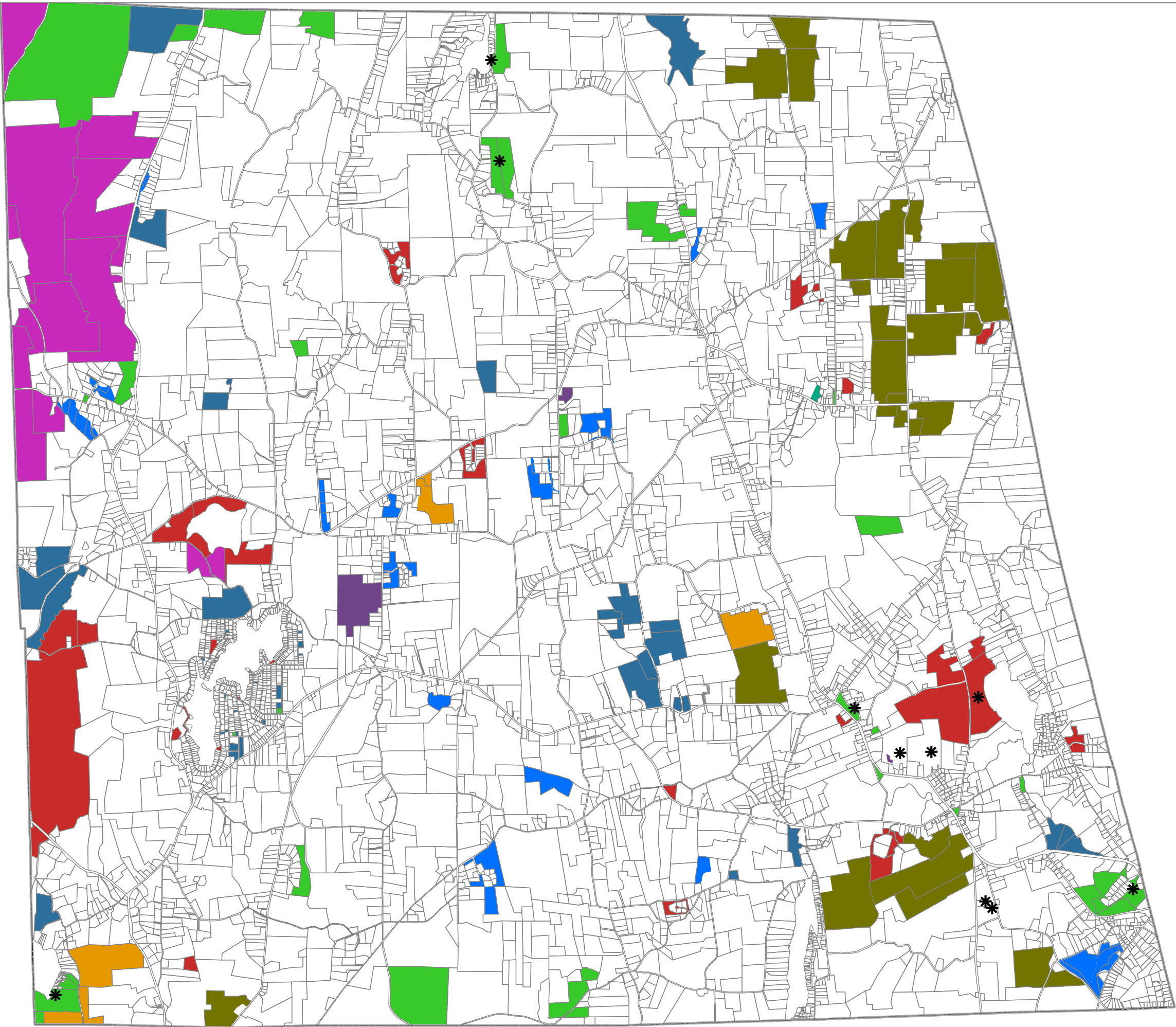


Town of Woodstock Open Space

Notes: The term 'open space' refers to various different methods of landpreservation. Open space can be created via a subdivision; donation by property owners to the municipality, a land trust or to the state; or to restrict the future use with a conservation easement. Another method of land preservation is to have the state Purchase the Development Rights leaving certain specified rights with the land such as for farming, often with a limited residential use of the property for the future.
