



With the up and coming storm we are expected to get a significant amount of snow. People should prepare for around 12 inches of snow followed by what could be 50 mph winds and subzero temperatures.

Residents should take precautions now such as turning your heat up in your homes a little higher than normal in case of power outages and running generators along with having extra fuel available. Also, people should consider bringing extra wood if you use this as a heat source to make it accessible.

If there are power outages and people need warming stations the town hall will ONLY be open during normal operating hours, if they close due to the storm they will NOT be open. The Bungay Fire Brigade (pet friendly - a family member will be with pet at all times) and Muddy Brook fire department will open as a warming shelter if there are power outages and people need a place to go. You will need to have any and all items you need if you go to a warming station (example blankets, medications, food, drink, entertainment) If more places open up as warming shelters I will update this post to include those locations.

If you have an emergency remember to call 911 first. If your pipes freeze please be careful in how you try to thaw them out and make sure it is in a safe manor.

During any storm please refrain from leaving your home unless it is necessary as road continues could be hazardous.
